State Congress: Election Results

Municipal Election Results

- 1. The PRI returns to a relatively strong position locally in Baja (State Congress and Municipalities).*
- 2. The PRI increased its percentage of votes for local deputies: in 2007 it had a disadvantage of 6.7% compared to PAN; now PRI has an advantage of 4.6%. With this vote, the PRI has achieved a strong majority in the State congress. The PRI has 15 of the 26 total deputies.*
- 3. In general, PAN lost 8.8% of votes for State Congress, confirming its 2007 defeat.*
- 4. The PRI increased its voting percentage for municipal elections: in 2007 it had a disadvantage of 2.9% compared to PAN; now PRI has an advantage of 6.5% controlling all 5 of municipalities of the State.*
- 5. In general, the PAN lost 8.6% in its voting participation in relation to municipalities.*
