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*In principle, the candidate of the PRD+PAN+CONV alliance, Xóchitl Gálvez, should have been the “poster girl” of the whole alliance strategy. Gálvez from a local Otomí family, born in Hidalgo, Valle de Mezquital, educated locally and earning a degree in computer engineering from the UNAM, she was recognized as the one progressive in the Fox cabinet as head of Indian Affairs. She resigned from the Calderón government in December of 2006 over budget cuts for indigenous programs, and began campaigning for Governor in 2007. But, something didn’t jell. The alliance selection process for Governor was bumpy with contentious polling and tardy decisions.*

*Her candidacy appears to have been underfunded and under-supported by the alliance. Further, the campaign itself seemed traditional in form and innocent in style.*

*Unlike the dynamic in Sinaloa and Puebla, this Alliance candidate was not a Priista. Unlike Puebla, the Alliance did not have PANAL support. And, unlike Oaxaca, this candidate did not have a clear long-term grassroots strategy.*

*The PRI held the Governorship and local Congress (p 2 and 4).*

*Municipal elections were not on the calendar, and consequently there is no new measure of municipal level party strength. The chart on page 5 shows the current measure with a strong PRI, especially in alliance with the PANAL.*
