Municipal Election Results

The PRI secured a majority of votes for Governor (52.6%) for the first time since 1993. In succeeding elections, PRI has won with plurality - 1999 with 44.4% and 2004 with 40.6%. (see page 2)

The PRD PAN alliance was not helped by its pre-election confusion and wrangling over nominees. Nonetheless, the Sanchez candidacy did not show up strongly in the pre-electoral polls generally. (p. 3)

It is hard to find any evidence in the polling and electoral numbers for a conspiracy against Sanchez, apart from his own legal vulnerabilities.

The PRI appears to be in a strong position in the state-level Congress, giving the new Governor a majority of 14 of 24 seats. (p. 5)

However at the municipal level, the dynamic is interesting. The PRI holds 4 of the 9 municipalities in the State. From 2004 when the PAN held one municipality and the PRD another, the Alliance now has 5 municipalities (p. 6).

The overstatement of PRI support in the exit polls is a puzzle. It may have to do less with sampling problems than with respondent confusion or misinformation at the moment of leaving the poll. Nonetheless, even the Quick Count of Mitofsky is off by 4%, a very high differential for a quick count. This bears follow up analysis.
